Scholarship Application & Mobilisation Process for Scholars with Disability

1



Australia Awards Myanmar begins promotion, including outreach to potential applicants with disabilities

2



Applicants disclose any disability and indicate what support they would need to participate in the program via the online application

3



Australia Awards Myanmar reviews applications and makes reasonable adjustments to enable participation in an IELTS test and interview for shortlisted applicants

6



Australia Awards Myanmar connects successful applicants with a Disability Support Consultant to conduct an assessment and develop a tailored support plan for mobilisation

5



Successful applicants with disabilities complete a Disability Support Statement (DSS)

4



Successful applicants with disabilities complete a medical report

7



The Disability Support Consultant reviews the DSS and develops a Disability Support Agreement (DSA)

8



Successful applicants receive an Australian university offer

9



The DSA is agreed and signed by the successful applicants, DFAT, and the university

12



Scholars mobilise to Australia

11



Scholars attend the Pre-Departure Briefing, with reasonable adjustments made to facilitate the participation of scholars with disabilities

10



DFAT officially offers successful applicants an Australia Awards Scholarship

13



Australian universities conduct on-award activities
The DSA can be adjusted at any time while on-award by contacting the Student Contact Officer at each university

14



Scholars complete their studies and return to Myanmar
